

CCSC Figure Skating Code of Conduct

The CCSC Figure Skater Code of Conduct is symbolized by the club's objective to provide all levels of skating instruction with an emphasis on good sportsmanship and trying your best. Skaters, parents and spectators should approach the skating time with a positive attitude and treat their fellow skaters and coaches with respect. Ridiculing or taunting coaches or other skaters is not acceptable and will not be tolerated. Skaters and their families are reminded that the Chester County Skating Club is a family oriented facility offering the students a non-competitive environment.

Skater Code of Conduct

CCSC figure skating participants are expected to show good sportsmanship and respect at all times to parents, coaches, fellow skaters and spectators. Skaters must follow the instruction of their coaches during instruction, practice and Ice Show rehearsal time. Skaters must adhere to CCSC safety code at all times while on the premises, on the ice or not. Coaches should be treated with the utmost respect and your ice time should be approached with a positive attitude and a determination to try your best and make the most of your time on the ice. Failure to do so will disqualify skaters from the program at CCSC.

Parent Code of Conduct

CCSC figure skating parents are expected to show good sportsmanship and respect at all times to your child, your child's coaches, fellow participating skaters and spectators. Parents, regardless of any coaching experience, are not to coach their child from the sideline during ice time. Involvement as a parent and spectator must be limited to positive statements or constructive feedback direct to your child's coach to encourage good sportsmanship and respect to all involved. Parents should respect the coach's decisions on skating time, level of instruction and performance practice and participation. Coaches should be made aware of any planned absences from instruction or practice and should be made aware of any illnesses or injuries that prevent your child from skating. It is your responsibility to pass along the code of conduct to visiting friends and family members. Failure to follow this code will exclude your child from the participation in the figure skating program and, possibly, CCSC.

Agreement Signatures

Each participant and parent must read and sign the Code of Conduct form before instruction will commence. Any failure to follow the Code of Conduct will be brought to the CCSC Board of Directors and may result in the skater's exclusion from the figure skating program as well as CCSC.

It is understood that we have read the above guidelines and will adhere to them. We understand that if this agreement is NOT signed by All parties and returned to the coaches or skating committee member, the skater will be ineligible for figure skating instruction and ice time.
